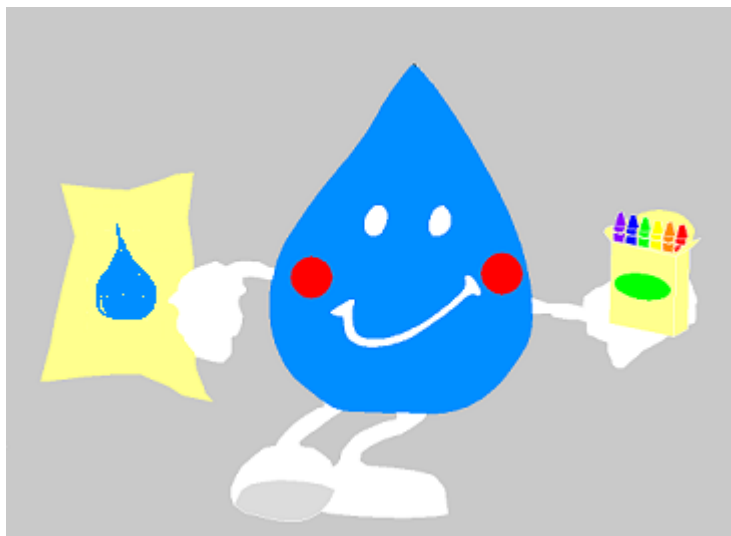

Re: AWWA NJ sponsors the fifth annual "National Drinking Water Week" poster competition

The American Water Works Association New Jersey Section (AWWA NJ) is sponsoring the fifth annual "National Drinking Water Week" poster contest as part of our weeklong celebration of drinking water.

Poster Contest Rules:

1. Entry is open to children in **grades K-5**. Children are encouraged to invite their grade school teachers and classes to participate in the poster competition. Prizes will be awarded to individuals as well as participating classrooms.
2. The poster must relate to the theme of "Only Tap Water Delivers" and should illustrate the importance of water in our society. Encourage the children to be creative.
3. The finished posters should be on 11" x 17" sized paper. Children are allowed to use only colored pencils, crayons or markers in the making of their posters. Collages will be disqualified.
4. Criteria for judging: creativity, use of color, and how well the poster expresses the contest theme 'Only Tap Water Delivers'. Spelling counts.
5. Only one entry per child will be allowed. Parents/sponsors are limited to verbal assistance only. All drawings must be an individual effort and be free-hand originals. No traced pictures please.
6. Each poster must have contestant's name, age, school, and telephone number. If applicable, please submit the sponsoring AWWA NJ member name and membership number (if known). The information should be clearly printed on the entry form and attached to the back of the poster to be eligible.
7. All entries must be received by **Wednesday, April 28, 2010** and should be sent to:

8. All entries become the property of AWWA NJ once submitted. Entry constitutes permission for AWWA NJ to use participants' and winners' names, photographs/likenesses of the poster design, or photographs of prize presentation(s) for public relations purposes, for appearance in any exhibition on behalf of NJAWWA, or for any other purposes consistent with the aims of the Association. Posters received prior to April 9, 2010 will be displayed at the AWWA NJ Annual Conference in Atlantic City.
9. Prizes will be awarded in two categories for three different age groups; Grades K-1; Grades 2-3 and Grades 4-5

Overall Poster Winners: One individual per age group. The students who design the overall winning posters will each receive a \$100 Visa Check Card and a framed copy of their poster.

Classroom/Participation Prizes: One class per age group. The teacher with the most posters in the contest will win a pizza party for his/her classroom, and a presentation from AWWA NJ during the week of May 10-14, 2010.
