COMMUNICATIONS

Promotes the AWWA NJ as the authority on water quality and other drinking water matters in New Jersey and informs the public on water quality and other drinking water issues.

Public Information Committee:

Communicates with public interest groups, other professional organizations and mass media in the State; coordinates Drinking Water Week activities; works to improve media exposure of AWWA.

Publications Committee:

Responsible for creation and publication of AWWA NJ newsletter, *Pipeline*, and content of the Section website at www.njanwwa.org.

Social Media Ad Hoc Committee:

Coordinates the Section's use of social media resources and evaluates ways for the Section to grow communication and outreach to members and nonmembers.

CONFERENCE & RECOGNITION

Develops programs, awards and associated activities which are structured to promote the professionalism, technical expertise and networking of AWWA NJ members while promoting the public awareness of the water works industry in New Jersey.

Conference Committee:

Coordinates with other Conference committees to produce Spring and Fall Conferences; coordinates local arrangements.

Develops technical program at Spring and Fall Conferences.

Coordinates vendor participation in Section activities.

Coordinates member recognition with Section and National awards.

EDUCATION

Provides AWWA NJ members with educational and professional development activities for the improvement of all aspects of the water utility industry.

Education & Professional Development

Committee: Develops informational and accredited programs for member professional development; oversees continuing education credit program.

Research & Technology Transfer Committee:

Encourages and sponsors research and dissemination of research information among members.

Operational Risk Committee:

Provides safety and security related information and educational programs.

Infrastructure Management Ad Hoc Committee:

Promotes asset management principles, infrastructure financing options, and management and infrastructure improvement in both municipal and private water and wastewater systems.

LEGISLATION & REGULATION

Monitors legislative, regulatory, and policy issues at State and federal levels of government, and provides input to regulatory and legislative authorities with the assistance of AWWA NJ members and coalitions of other State water and environmental organizations.

Water Utility Council (WUC):

Maintains program for monitoring and influencing legislation and regulations in the State that impact water utility systems, their environment and their customers; communicates with AWWA NJ membership on legislative and regulatory matters.

Drinking Water Quality Regulatory Ad Hoc

Committee: Monitors and influences regulatory development; provides technical expertise to the WUC; facilitates communication with Section membership on regulatory matters; makes recommendations on education and training needs for members.
